

## RESPONSIBILITY

THE THREE COMPONENTS OF RESPONSIBILITY

- <u>MATURITY</u> -- HAS THE INDIVIDUAL REACHED THE MENTAL AND PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENTAL LEVEL NECESSARY TO HANDLE THE TASK?
- <u>COMPETENCE</u> -- DOES THE INDIVIDUAL HAVE THE SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THE TASK?
- <u>MOTIVATION</u> -- DOES THE INDIVIDUAL HAVE THE DESIRE AND INTEREST NECESSARY TO PERSIST ON AND COMPLETE THE TASK?

## CONTROL

THE TWO AREAS OF CONTROL

- ACCOUNTABILITY BEING IN A POSITION TO ACCEPT THE RESULTS AND/OR CONSEQUENCES OF CHOICES MADE. UNDERSTANDING THE IMPACT OF THEIR DECISIONS ON OTHERS, AND ON THE OVERALL SUCCESS OF THE TASK AT HAND.
- <u>SELF-REGULATION</u>— GAUGING THE POTENTIAL RISK, AND MAKING DECISIONS BASED ON THE AMOUN OF RISK THEY ARE WILLING TO ASSUME. DELAYING GRATIFICATION WHEN NECESSARY, AND PRIORITIZING ACTIONS, NEEDS, AND DESIRES.
